






Overall, income is down, particularly with the loss of rent from the Saturday School.



The committee was formed to review IFN bylaws and to come up with recommendations for amendments. The committee presented to the board its charter, members, and timeline.








Finance Report

Construction Committee Update

The committee set up the following plan:

- Apply for Planning & Zoning in January/February 2021.
- Once Zoning is approved by the relevant department, the City Council usually approves within a month (March).
- Building Permit drawings will then follow and take 4 months for the architect and engineers to complete (July).
- The City of Waukegan will take another 3 months to review and approve the Building Permit (October).

However, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Waukegan is slow in its response to applications. We will have a better idea of the timing in the coming weeks.





Finance Update / Q3 Results




Due to the COVID-19 pandemic continuing, income was significantly down in the Q3 results in some areas such as Sunday School tuition collection, and Saturday School rent

collection. Enrollment in Sunday School was down compared to last year, and tuition was discounted by 50% for those who did register, especially given that lunch was not being provided.




Expenses were also significantly down, a good thing in this case.


Sadaqa and others



Sadaqa collection and disbursement usually runs from Ramadan to Ramadan, which explains the positive balance of the account (funds are still being disbursed). We usually cater to our IFN community first, but then expand to the Lake County area and larger Chicago area if funds remain.

Fall Fundraising Final Numbers & Next Steps

The board set a goal of raising \$100,000 but received pledges for around \$75,000. Out of these pledges, the board collected around \$43,000 as of December. Work continues with the youth to send out reminder emails to the community. The goal is to collect all pledges by March 2021.

Youth Strategy Update

The Youth Strategy team completed all its work and handed over execution of the final recommendations to the Executive Committee.

Construction Update

The planned application for Zoning was pushed to January. For December, a pre-application meeting with City officials will take place, to give them a preview of what is to come.
