


Let's Expand Our Mosque !!!

JULY UPDATES

- 1) IFN Campus Expansion is an addition to the current facility. The expansion is motivated by IFN's desire to serve the community better and meet practical needs, better service the purpose of religious instructions to future generations and serve as a model Islamic community institution.
- 2) There will be three component of buildings: one to serve the community's academic goals, second to provide social services, and third to serve the community's religious needs. They are designed to be inter-related and inter-connected




3) The future Academic wing will have 24 classrooms, offices, teacher's rooms, meeting rooms. There will be an open gallery for use for lectures, gathering and space for students to hang out. The future Social wing will have indoor Gymnasium, 3-lane track for walking, jogging, and running. Large dining facility, Gym, Computer Center and library.

4) We have secured an Expansion approval by Waukegan Planning/Zoning/Community Development and City Council, now we are working towards getting construction Permit. The target is to start construction of the project in Spring of 2022.

5)The architect is working on the design documents and has involved all consultants in the process.

6) Planning effort is in progress for the annual fundraiser to be held in October.
